

Spatio-Temporal Data: The Case of the Marsh's Library

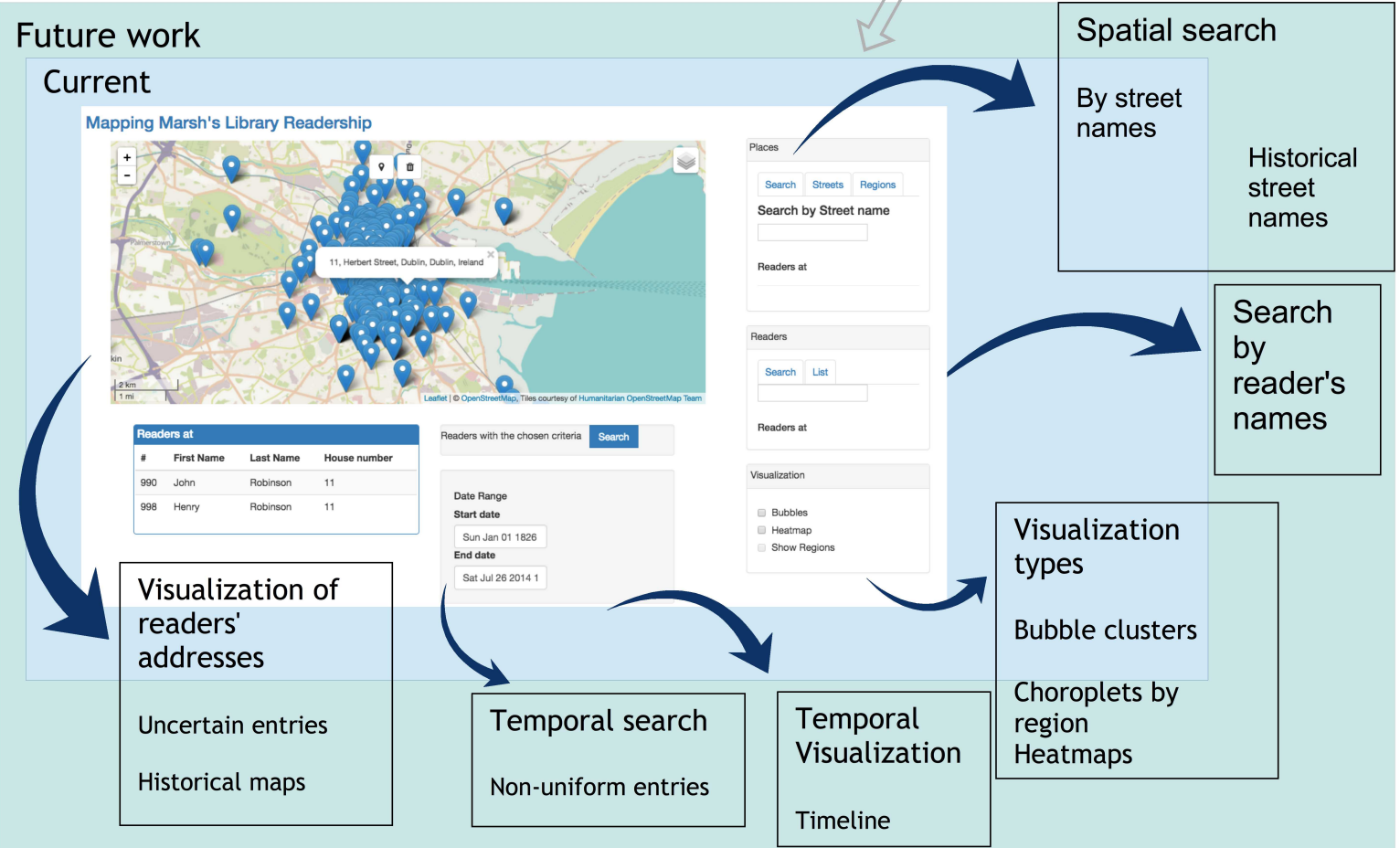
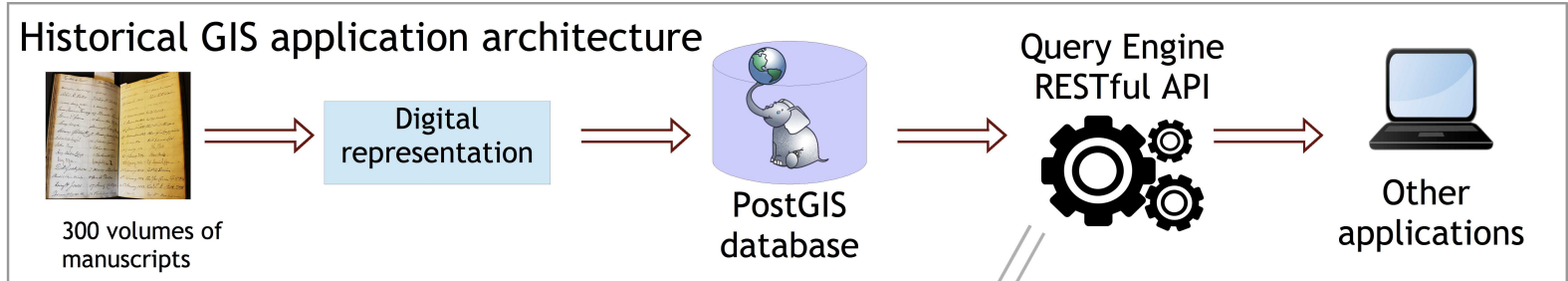

We describe an open source prototype of a historical GIS application based on records from Marsh's Library in Dublin over the period between 1826 and 1926. This system includes an empirical data base of readers and readership, and a user-friendly visualization interface which will aid the analysis of readership information by academic specialists. Both will help to provide a rich seam of evidence as to the broader evolution of Dublin's intellectual and literary history.
